What to do if...	Action Needed	Return to school When...
...my child has COVID-19 symptoms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continuous cough • Temperature • Loss of taste 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school to inform us Email: attendance@avonbourneacademy.org.uk or phone the attendance team before 8:00am • Self-isolate the whole household • https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/ gives details of COVID-19 symptoms • Get a test for your child or anyone who is symptomatic in the household • Inform the school immediately about the test result 	...the test comes back negative or a period of 10 days has passed since the symptoms started, and your child feels well.
...my child test positive for COVID-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact the school to inform us Email: attendance@avonbourneacademy.org.uk or phone the attendance team before 8:00am • Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum 10 days) • Self-Isolate the whole household (household members only need to get tested if they are symptomatic) 	...10 days have passed since symptoms began, even if they still have a cough or loss of taste/smell. And child feels well
...my child tests negative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact the school to inform us Email: attendance@avonbourneacademy.org.uk or phone the attendance team before 8:00am • Discuss when your child can come back (same day/next day) 	...the test comes back negative
...my child is ill with symptoms not linked to COVID-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school to inform us Email: attendance@avonbourneacademy.org.uk or phone the attendance team before 8:00am • Ring on each day of illness 	...after 48 hours following the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea
...someone in my household has COVID-19 symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school to inform us Email: attendance@avonbourneacademy.org.uk or phone the attendance team before 8:00am • Self-isolate with the whole household • Household member to get tested • Child does not need a test unless symptomatic • Inform school immediately of test result 	...the test comes back negative
...someone in my household tests positive for COVID-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school to inform us Email: attendance@avonbourneacademy.org.uk or phone the attendance team before 8:00am • Self-isolate with the whole household • Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum 14 days) 	...the child has completed 14 days of isolation.
...NHS test and trace has identified my child as a close contact of	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school to inform us 	...the child has completed 14 days of isolation.

somebody with symptoms or confirmed COVID-19	<p>Email: attendance@avonbourneacademy.org.uk or phone the attendance team before 8:00am</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum 14 days) 	
...NHS test and trace has identified a household member (other than my child) as in close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed COVID-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The household member must self-isolate for 14 days • Child can return to school 	...child can continue to attend school.
... A sibling attending another school has been sent home to self-isolate due to there being a positive case in their school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The sent home sibling must self-isolate for 14 days • Avonbourne School children can continue to attend school 	...child can continue to attend school.
...my child has travelled abroad from a country that is NOT on the exempt list of countries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Minimum of 14 days self-isolation for all those in the household • Contact school to inform us you are back in the country and we will agree earliest date of return • https://www.gov.uk/foreign-travelguide for up to date travel information 	...the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed.
...my child has travelled to a country that IS on the exempt list of countries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quarantine is not needed • https://www.gov.uk/foreign-travelguide for up to date travel information • Contact school to inform us you are back in the country and we will agree earliest date of return 	...you have informed the office of your return to the UK and you are exempt from self-isolation.
...I have travelled from a country that requires us to quarantine (but my child did not travel)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As long as you do not have/have not had symptoms in the last 14 days, your child can continue to attend school. • The person who has travelled MUST NOT leave the house, including to do pick-ups and drop offs. 	...child can continue to attend school.
...we received medical advice that my child must resume shielding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school. • Contact school to inform us. <p>Email: attendance@avonbourneacademy.org.uk or phone the attendance team before 8:00am</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shield until you are informed that • restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again. 	<p>...school inform you that restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school again.</p> <p>...you receive medical advice that your child may return to school.</p>
...my child's bubble is closed due to COVID-19 outbreak in school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Child must not come to school • Support your child at home with remote education provided by your school. • Your child will need to self-isolate for 14 days. • Other siblings may continue to attend school 	...school inform you that the bubble will be reopened.
...I am unable to get a test for someone in the household	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you are unable to get a test in the first 5 days of having symptoms, your child and your household must self-isolate for 14 days. 	...the child has completed 14 days of self-isolation.
