Re: Year 10 Mock Assessments

Firstly, can I commend all the students on their hard work over the last few weeks at the revision sessions. It has been great to see them making the most of the opportunities available to them to fully prepare for the upcoming examinations which will be held between 7 and 18 June 2021.

All examinations will take place formally in the hall during this period and all exam access arrangements will be taken into account.

Enclosed is a timetable for the examinations and a booklet to support students with their revision and preparation. Period 0 morning revision will take place from 8:00 – 8:25 on the morning of the exam and there will be recorded revision sessions available on Teams for the mid-morning exams that students can access the evening prior to their exam. Please see the timetable in the support pages pack.

This is an important set of examinations for Year 10 students, who, due to school closures over the last year, have not had the opportunity to sit formalised assessments for 18 months now. Not only will this examination period allow them an invaluable 'rehearsal' for terminal GCSE examinations next year, but the results will be used to make our first set of predictions for the year group which many students will find they will be asked for when they begin to apply for their post-16 courses in September. The results will also be used to make decisions around tiers of entry in maths, science and MFL, and to place students into their sets at the start of Year 11.

The results of these examinations along with predictions for all subjects will be shared with you at the end of the academic year.
