# Mock Exam Logistics – Why do we do mocks?

---

- PRACTICE

- Where to go
- Requirements of each exam
- Completing a large number of exams
- Managing intense revision over a 4 (ish) week period

# Mock Exam Logistics

---

- The majority of students will sit the exam in the Roy Moore Sports Hall
- Students with Exam Access Arrangements may be in a different room e.g. if have a reader in a computer room
- Provided with JCQ regulations with regards to official regulations the centre and the candidates must abide by
- All have timetable – seats, exam room & tier entry
- All have support pages
- Any student who misses an exam will sit it at the first available opportunity when they are back in school – most likely be after 3.30pm

# Mock Exam Logistics – Top Tips

---

- Make the most of the revision sessions on offer
- Prepare well by completing effective revision
- Make sure you know your seat number for each exam
- If you are entitled to extra provisions scribe, prompt, reader or extra time take advantage of this
- Check your exam paper at the start
- Write your name on everything you write on
- Arrive on time
- Listen carefully to all instructions
- Official Requirements – mobile phones do not enter the exam room
