Curriculum Information - Autumn 1

As part of our commitment to strengthening communication between parents/carers and the Academy, we would like to ensure that parents and carers are able to easily access information on what their child is learning at school, to enable positive discussions and support around this at home.

What will my Year 7 child learn during Autumn 1?

English	Year 7 students will explore extracts from Jane Eyre, focusing on characterisation and
	themes such as the role of women, childhood, religion, power, and social class. They will
	develop their critical voice and analyse methods of characterisation.
Maths	Students will work with decimals, negative numbers, and place value. They will then move
	on to the order of operations (BIDMAS) and an introduction to algebra.
Science	Year 7 begins with the particle model and states of matter. They will learn how mixtures
	are separated using techniques like filtration, distillation, and chromatography.
MFL	In French and Spanish, students will learn basic language skills, including introducing
	themselves and discussing family, friends, likes, and dislikes.
History	Year 7 historians will explore the year 1000, focusing on global interconnectedness,
	including Constantinople, Baghdad, and European Christendom.
Geography	Students will start by learning key geographical skills, including grid references, scale, and
	map use, before studying climatic zones and the causes and effects of climate change.
Art	Students will learn colour theory and develop painting and drawing skills, exploring
	expressive line and colour through the work of Vincent Van Gogh.
Music	Year 7 musicians will learn rhythm, pulse, and performance by playing 'Ode to Joy' on the
	keyboard, focusing on accuracy.
Religious	Students will explore modern British society through the 2021 Census, investigating religious
Studies	and non-religious groups and changes over time, with a focus on the local area.
PE	Students will develop skills in Handball, HRF, Netball, Basketball, and Badminton, focusing
	on fitness, teamwork, and leadership through activities that build strength, stamina, and
	coordination.
Drama	Year 7 will explore three movement concepts—actions, dynamics, and space—using a
	popular music video as inspiration, learning how to create and vary movement sequences.
	Students will be introduced to foundational Drama skills, including focus, concentration,
	ensemble work, voice, and physicality, which form the toolkit for their learning.
PSHE	This term focuses on self-value, teamwork, respecting differences, and managing mental
	and emotional health as students settle into Avonbourne.
D&T	Students will rotate through graphic design, food technology, and textiles, making a
	mechanical card, learning hand embroidery, and cooking simple dishes like pizza toast and
Computer	scones. Year 7 will explore the impact of technology, focusing on online safety, password security,
Science	and becoming responsible digital citizens.
