Changes to Free School Meal Entitlement - ACTION REQUIRED

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. Healthy school food can help pupils establish healthy habits for life and help to improve pupils' readiness to learn.

The criteria for free school meals and other funding has changed.

If your child currently is in receipt of free school meals or pupil premium, you need to check your eligibility for the next academic year by completing the link below. If you do not, your child's access to free school meals will end.

If you haven't been eligible before, you may now be entitled to receive free school meals if you are in receipt of certain benefits or support. You could also raise additional pupil premium funding for the academies to fund support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or extra-curricular activities.
