Avonbourne Academies Ski Trip: Les Deux Alps, France. Friday 26th March – Friday 2nd April 2027

We are thrilled to offer your child the exciting opportunity to join our annual Easter Ski Trip! This year, we will be staying at the charming Hotel La Meije in Les Deux Alpes, France, a world-class destination boasting an impressive 225 km of skiing to explore and 96 diverse runs. The trip is being organised in partnership with Select Ski, a trusted provider with whom some of our staff have previously travelled with. The hotel offers a fantastic range of amenities, including games rooms and modern, comfortable bedrooms, ensuring your child has an unforgettable experience both on and off the slopes. This residential trip will be taking place over the first week of the Easter break, Friday 26th March to Friday 2nd April 2027. The total cost of is **£1,550** per student. Please note that this price is subject to 40 paying students; so, if less places are reserved then a supplement may be charged.

The package includes:

- Travel to France by coach
- Full board accommodation (including a hot cooked lunch at the hotel)
- Multi-bedded single sex rooms all with ensuite
- Five days skiing, with lessons from the local ski school (5 hours per day plus 1 hour lunchtime)
- Hire of ski equipment (skis, boots, poles, and ski helmets)
- Five-day lift pass
- A variety of evening activities included in the price (e.g laser quest, bowling, disco)
- Fully comprehensive insurance, including full medical cover
- Covid guarantee 100% refund, in case of ski resort, hotel closure or if destination country does not allow visitors.

To gain a place on the trip, parents/carers need to fill in the Microsoft form which will **go live from Thursday 22nd January and will close on Monday 26th January.** [Expression of Interest- Ski Trip Easter 2027 – Fill in form](#)

Places will then be granted as per our trips policy. Those who gain a place on the trip will receive a confirmation letter with the schedule for payments, which will be sent out within two weeks. A reserve list will be generated based on demand. An initial deposit of £150 is non-refundable, except in very special circumstances or if insufficient numbers are obtained to proceed with the trip. Further cancellation charges may apply depending on the date and circumstances of notification.

In order to travel, students will require a valid passport with at least 3 months validity remaining at the end of the trip, a GHIC card, and if applicable a visa. It is the parent/carer's responsibility to ensure this is arranged in plenty of time.
