Refreshments will be on sale on the night, so students may want to bring some extra cash in a named purse or wallet (we suggest no more than £2). Refreshments will be clearly labelled with allergy information and will not contain nuts.

Please note, no mobile phones will be allowed at the disco. If students need to have these on them for contact purposes, they will be able to hand them in at the beginning of the disco and receive them again at the end.

Drop off and collection will be from **Student Reception** and all students must be collected from site by the adult named on the Microsoft Form. Students will under no circumstances be permitted to walk home unattended at the end of the evening.

There are a maximum of 200 tickets available due to space restrictions, so tickets will be allocated on a first come first served basis. A text message will be sent home confirming your child's place at the disco on Monday 7th October. If received, please send your child in with £4 (correct change is greatly appreciated) to purchase their ticket from Student Reception in Block B during lunchtime on Tuesday 8th, Thursday 10th and Friday 11th October 2024. Any ticket not purchased by the end of lunchtime on Friday 11th October will be allocated to any other students. Your child's place is only confirmed once payment has been made and you have received an email confirming so.
