Year 11 Leavers Assembly and Prom

Plan to follow the last whole cohort exam

Monday 16th June

Our last whole cohort exam is approaching on **16th June**. After the Physics exams, students will be permitted to leave school, **unless** they have a Music exam in the afternoon. Students will be leaving site during period 2 at staggered times based on their exam finish time. All Physics exams will be finished before break time. Students who study **Music** will have intervention period 2 and period 3 prior to their exam. Please be aware that students are not permitted to sign their shirts on this day, as exams are still taking place. Any poor behaviour on this day could lead to students not being able to attend our celebration events.

Tuesday 17th June

Please also note **on 17th June Spanish** students have an exam in the morning. Students who are sitting the Spanish exam should arrive at Student Reception for 8:40am to register. **Design Technology** students have a period 3 and period 4 intervention.

Wednesday 18th June

On **Wednesday 18th June**, **Design Technology** students have a period 0 intervention prior to their morning exam. Students who study **L2 extended Maths** will have an intervention period 3 prior to their exam in the afternoon.

For further clarification, students must attend all the above in school uniform.

Leavers' Event – Wednesday 25th June

Students are invited to join us on **Wednesday 25th June** for a farewell afternoon. Students should arrive via **Student Reception** and sign in at **3:35pm**. Students are expected to attend in **full school uniform**. We would be grateful if you are able to donate any unwanted/clean uniform, especially ties or blazers. If students can bring this on leavers day or afterwards to **Student Reception** that would be much appreciated.

As part of the event, students will have the opportunity to sign shirts and share messages with friends - a longstanding tradition and a lovely keepsake of their time here. Students will also receive their leavers' hoodies and yearbooks during this celebration event.
