Dear Parent/Carer,

Language Nut – new homework platform for French and Spanish

Following feedback from parents, carers and students on our existing homework platform, I am writing to inform you of a positive change to our Modern Foreign Languages homework this year.

From September, we are changing all our MFL homework over to the Language Nut platform, <https://www.languagenut.com/en-gb/>. This platform is designed to support students to build on their learning in class and will be used from Y7 until the end of Y11 as it offers exam skill practice as well as sentence-building, grammar and vocabulary tasks. Many other United Learning schools already use this platform and have seen great improvements in their ROA results.

Your child will initially need a separate login to use this platform. We hope to soon be able to link your child's Language Nut account with Microsoft to ensure easy access. To support your child initially, they will be given a copy of their username and password to keep safe in their pencil case while we get started on the platform. I will be in touch again when we are able to link these to the Microsoft logins and reduce the need for a separate password.

To further support your child and parents/carers, I have created a video showing how to login to the platform and complete homework tasks, which can be found here: [Language Nut Tutorial.webm](#)

Your child will be shown this video in class by their teacher, and they will have the opportunity to ask any questions, and we will be holding weekly Language Nut homework sessions after school on **Wednesdays** in **BG27** to support students with logging in for the first time or for any other concerns. If your child is unable to stay after school and requires support or a password reminder, they can find Miss Turner at breaktime in BU12.

We are very excited about this new platform and the impact it will have on your child's progress, attainment and engagement in languages. We also hope to run competitions later in the school year to further enhance our French and Spanish provision at Avonbourne.
